Navigating the most dysfunctional (?) and possibly the most consequential relationship of the entire enterprise operating model

- Growing GBS digitalization needs and what it means when IT controls the roadmap but GBS owns the pain
- The hypocritical courting situation? How to deal with global automation roadmap when IT & technology sit at global level, very often "above" GBS
- Talking a common language is a 2-way street: Technical fluency on one side and business acumen on the other to steer in the same direction
- AI governance at the intersection of GBS and IT: Who owns the guardrails and who carries the liability when something goes wrong?

- Efficiency over effectiveness: Smart standardization and cost optimization as competitive advantages for the region to stay relevant
- "Finance transformation" - buzzwords or motto to live by?
- "Not all finance functions can be offshored": Reality or turning a blind eye to the facts?

- When "acceptable" matters more than "compliant": Processes only matter to us, stakeholders want effort, speed and clarity
- Process excellence is worthless without service design: Green process KPIs don't always mean customer satisfaction
- Changing old habits: If you keep calling them „clients“, don't be surprised if you are just a „supplier“ (and suppliers can easily be changed)
- The smartphone effect: Immediate availability, user-friendliness, self-service, after-sales, IT reliability... or when consumer-grade experience should bleed into corporate expectations
